In honor of our first growth, we have put together, with the help of some generous donors, a lovely little tribute. Château Mouton Rothschild is known for bringing the most celebrated artists of their day together to create their wine labels and this trio is no exception to that. The 1973 Château Mouton Rothschild label was designed by Pablo Picasso. The 1973 vintage is also special because it was the first vintage that Château Mouton Rothschild was classified as a first growth. Dutch painter Karel Appel designed the 1994 label. The 1994 vintage was rated 91 points by Robert Parker and "...exhibits a dense, saturated purple color, followed by a classic Mouton nose of sweet black fruits intermingled with smoke, pain grillee, spice, and cedar." British painter Lucian Freud deigned the 2006 Château Mouton Rothschild label. Rated 96 points by Robert Parker, he says that the 2006 Château Mouton Rothschild "has quite brilliant delineation with blackberry, graphite, here an almost cold slate-like scent. The palate is harmonious with the carefully judged acidity, fine-grain tannin and immense detail on the finish."

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## **701** 3 - bottles Château Cheval Blanc Le Petit Cheval 2010 estimated value: \$750

"The best second wine I have ever tasted from Cheval Blanc is the 2010 Le Petit Cheval. This wine is essentially three-fourths Merlot and the rest Cabernet Franc. Rivaling the brilliant 2009, thirty percent of the production from this monstrously sized estate made it into this wine, which offers up plenty of white chocolate, cassis and mulberry as well as a hint of roasted herbs. With fleshy, round flavors, full-bodied texture and an amazing finish, this is no second wine, and considerably better than some of the Cheval Blancs of the 1960s and 1970s!" 93 points – Robert Parker

From the start-up days at this famous joint venture between Robert Mondavi and Bordeaux's Baron Philippe de Rothschild. The 1981 harvest was one of the earliest in Napa Valley history, after a mild winter hastened an early bud break and a very hot June ripened the grapes quickly. The wine produced that year, a blend of 93% Cabernet Sauvignon and 7% Cabernet Franc aged for 22 months in French oak, wasn't your typical plush style, but instead something leaner and more elegant. - K&L Notes

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## **722** **3 - Double Magnums Château L'Eglise-Clinet 2010** estimated value: \$5,000

"This wine will likely be a major superstar with about 10-15 years of cellaring. It was one of the more closed and difficult wines to penetrate and one of probably only a dozen or so 2010s that I only had one chance to taste from bottle, but it is loaded with fabulous raw materials. The 2010 is a profound effort, but it needs to be forgotten for at least a decade. This opaque purple wine offers up notes of caramelized black currant and black cherry candies intermixed with some very high class, subtle vanillin and toast. Hints of licorice, mocha and perhaps even a touch of chocolate are also present in this full-bodied, super-duper, concentrated, classic wine, which has everything in perfect proportions. But in the finish, its whoppingly big tannins kick in and basically announce that drinking this wine now would be infanticide. Look for this wine to last for at least 50+ years." - 96+ points, Robert Parker
