"Beaujolais has always been a gateway to the Côte d'Or for me. Often much fruitier and juicier when young, many of the crus can shed their baby fat and mature similarly to village-level and even some lesser premier crus. Like other parts of Burgundy, terroir has as much of a role as producer in the final result. For example, Morgon and Chiroubles share a border but the wines are remarkably different due to elevation and soil variation. Juge officially retired in the late '90s. The majority of his vineyards he passed to his daughter, Olga. Starting in 2005, she decided she didn't want to spend the time and effort to commercialize her wines, so Marcel invoked a provision in French law that allowed him to continue to make a tiny bit of wine - post-retirement

- as a sort of “bricolage” (or hobby). So now, each year, he makes about 150 cases of his super-traditional Cornas for personal consumption as well as some for his close friends.

Domaine Huet is the undisputed leader of the Vouvray appellation on the north bank of the Loire River where the chenin blanc grape is king. The exemplary house style here is one of purity of expression and the wines are legendary for their tautness and minerality. Huet is certainly the greatest domaine in all of Vouvray, if not all of the Loire and its current proprietor is Chinese-American financier, Anthony Hwang, also owner of the famed Királyudvar estate in Tokaji in Hungary.

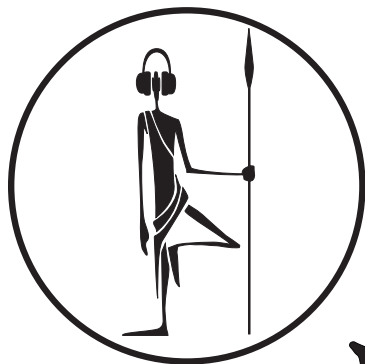
