2004: This fascinating wine is bone dry and tart in acids, with citrus, melon, fig, and gooseberry flavors that finish with a rich spiciness. Be careful not to chill it too much. You might even want to decant it for a while before refrigerating. It gets better as it breathes in the glass.

2008: A beautiful straw yellow color with green highlights. The nose is an intense combination of citrus and floral notes mixed with pronounced stony minerality – a complex marriage of varietal and specific terroir. The palate is silky and elegant. Clean flavors of lime, grapefruit, white peach, apricot, and hints of linden echo the wine's aromas.

2014: Very aromatic in the glass, the wine suggests honeysuckle, white peach, pear, and tropical fruits. The entry is full, rich, and textured, with abundant fruit balanced by bright acidity. It retains its weight, volume, and viscosity through the mid-palate to a fresh and persistent finish.

On the palate it creeps up on you slowly; the first impression is ripe yet delicate, then the fine-grained tannins charge through and light up the sky. Very long finish. Drink or hold."

The white received 94 points from Jeb Dunnuck, "A terrific white that's up with the top efforts in the vintage, the 2016 Château Malartic-Lagravière Blanc comes from a 7-hectare vineyard in the Graves region and is 85% Sauvignon and 15% Sémillon raised in 55% new

barrels. It has terrific freshness and purity as well as medium body, a concentrated, layered, texture, perfumed notes of lemon curd, white grapefruits, and flowers, and a distinct sense of minerality. The whites in the vintage have a good mix of purity and richness, and this is a great example. It's going to benefit from a year or two and drink well for at least a decade. Tasted twice, count me in as a fan."

Then in 2008, small blocks of Petite Manseng, Syrah, Touriga Nacional, Mourvedre and Petite Sirah were added, including 3.5 acres on its own roots. 

This wine cuts an even broader, more expansive flavor profile across the palate, offering gorgeous notes of creme de cassis, background oak and licorice, and hints of lead pencil shavings and spring flowers. Strikingly complex, this stunning wine reveals a freshness and vivacity that go against the general reputation of this vintage. It is a crunchy, juicy effort with 14.7% alcohol, although the latter component is not the least bit noticeable. Slightly more evolved than the basic Cabernet Sauvignon, this beauty is accessible now, so there is no reason to delay your pleasure. It should be strutting its stuff for 15-20 years." - Robert Parker

2020 Chateau Haut Segottes Vin de France M/R Danielle Meunier makes deeply classical wines at her highly regarded estate in Saint Emilion. She made this playful and approachable blend of merlot and cabernet franc as a tribute to her long relationship with US importer Neal Rosenthal and shaped it for the US market. It's charming.

2012 Parés Baltà Gran Reserva Cava Blanca Cusiné Maria Elena Jimenez and her sisterin-law Marta Casas created this long-aged traditional method gran reserva as a tribute to the women of Parés Baltà and especially the owners' daughter, Blanca. It's 81% xarel-lo, 9% chardonnay and 10% pinot noir, aged for 80 months. It is elegant with notes of apricot, honey, hazelnut and toast. Ever wondered how good artisan-made cava can be? This is a great example.

2019 Parés Baltà Gratavinum 2nr The same team of women winemakers created this savory blend, named for the perimeter of a circle because of their perception of the perfect roundness of this wine. It's 55% grenache, 30% carignan, 9% syrah and 6% cabernet sauvignon. As the name implies, it's big and round with red fruit and hints of cacao and smokiness...yet it has surprising freshness. Plush without being heavy.

2017 Oddero Barolo Oddero is one of the great and historic names in Barolo and Mariacristina Oddero is continuing their tradition of outstanding winemaking. This version is berry scented with hints of plum, leather, herb and spice. It's classic barolo—deep, lively and fresh. It will certainly age well but is surprisingly approachable.

2019 Melanie Pfister Alsace Paar Melanie, who has taken over her family's estate—and performed so well that her family insisted she put her name on the label—called this wine Paar (or Pair) because it's a 50/50 blend of pinot blanc and auxerrois (auxerrois is a sibling of chardonnay which is often blended with pinot blanc to add weight to the mix). It's floral and fresh, marked by purity of fruit. White wine authority Stuart Pigott recently saluted Pfister, saying: "Melanie Pfister is one of the most talented young winemakers in Alsace."

2017 Istine Toscana Rosato Angela Fronti makes this rosé from 100% sangiovese cold fermented in cement tanks in the heart of Chianti. It's light and fresh, with red fruits accented by hints of orange and lime. 2017 was the inaugural vintage for this wine—its popularity ensured continuation. It's a taste of summer in Italy in a glass!

2018 Kerr Cellars Reserve Red Cristie Kerr is a world-class professional golfer but she's not doing this as some kind of side project. She really loves wine and she puts her heart and soul into these wines. She and winemaker Helen Keplinger have made some incredible wines together.

2012 Carol Shelton Wild Thing Zin (magnum) Carol was among the first women to graduate from UC-Davis with a degree in enology. Whimsical, creative, and ever enthusiastic about her work, Carol Shelton has been lauded with countless medals and honors through the course of her 35-year winemaking career. In fact, she is said to be one of the most awarded

winemakers in the country. Wild Thing Zin is produced using wild yeasts from organically grown grapes.

2018 SEPPI Brut Rosé - The Phelps family name has been identified with fine Napa Valley and Sonoma Coast wines since the early 1970s. Today, Kelsey Phelps vinifies traditionalmethod California sparkling wines in honor of her grandfather, Joseph "Seppi" Phelps.

The police occasionally fined the bartenders, but otherwise, life proceeded. Rubin, however, decided the tailoring business was a safe bet and moved to the Stanton Park area. His brothers eventually divested themselves of the bar altogether.

In 1949, Abe Genderson, Rubin's son, returned to the liquor business in partnership with his father-in-law, Max Schneider. Their new establishment was known as Schneider's.

We are so excited to welcome Danielle Thompson from Almaviva for her first in-person Heart's Delight and you all have hopefully had a chance to try the 2019 and 2009 vintages she brought with her.

Enjoy this rare Methuselah (equivalent to 8 bottles) from Viña Almaviva, a château concept winery, established by Baron Philippe de Rothschild and Concha y Toro. One Bordeaux blend is released annually, offering the best of two worlds: Chilean terroir interlaced with French winemaking tradition. The result is an exceptionally elegant and layered wine, harmoniously balanced by structured tannins and a great acidity, crafted to savor now or to cellar for decades.

About this vintage: 2011 was dry, with all stages from bud break to harvest occurring later than usual. Yields were lower than normal with particularly small Cabernet Sauvignon and Carménère berries. These unique conditions favored superb quality of fruit, elegant and pure, with a notable density of ripe, round tannins. Complex and subtle, this wine reveals delicate and clean aromas of ripe cassis, fig and blackberries, accompanied by vanilla, cacao and toffee notes. The mouthfeel is smooth, well-refined with silky tannins, leaving an overall impression of balance, finesse, persistence, and freshness. This vintage is an assemblage of 67% Cabernet Sauvignon, 25% Carménère, 5% Cabernet Franc, 2% Merlot and 1% Petit Verdot, barrel aged for 17 months in new French oak.

"Very complex, sophisticated nose with clean Bordeaux influence. Super-bright, fresh fruit. Great precision. Luscious ripeness and no Carmenère greenness. Energy and polish. Balance. Rather unashamedly drier tannins than in most Chilean Cabernets. Clearly set for the long term." 18/20 points - Jancis Robinson, Decanter

95 points from Vinous and from James Suckling and 93 points from Robert Parker's Wine Advocate, "It has a special brightness and light, starting to slowly develop some complexity. The palate is concentrated, medium to full-bodied with ripe, round tannins, no edges, good concentration and weight. It's still a baby, a little marked by the oak, but with enough density and freshness to come into greater balance. It should grow up slowly and live a long life."

One day as Master Sommelier John Szabo pondered his response to the often asked question "What are your favorite wines?" he realized that though they were from diverse regions, all had one thing in common—they came from volcanic soils! That realization led him to years of research to understand why those wines so appealed to him—which led to the publishing of his authoritative book: Volcanic Wines: Salt, Grit and Power. This lot includes Szabo's book and 18 bottles of wine from different volcanic regions so you can explore Szabo's thoughts and compare them with your own!

John Szabo, Volcanic Wines: Salt, Grit and Power, Jacqui Small, 2016

2020 Tenuta delle Terre Nere Etna Bianco: From vineyards high up on Mt. Etna's lava-flecked soils, this fresh, minerally aromatic white, made from primarily carricante, earned 91 points from Antonio Galloni at Vinous

2019 Tenuta delle Terre Nere Etna Rosso Pre-Phylloxera Grand Cru: Terre Nere owner Marco de Grazia (born at Georgetown Hospital—so we can claim him as a DC native, though he moved to Italy young) noticed that within his finest old vine vineyard on Mt. Etna were a block of vines that were even older—that had survived the phylloxera infestation and were producing particularly elegant grapes at ~170 years old. He began bottling them separately as a Pre-Phylloxera Grand Cru. Primarily nerello mascalese, the 2019 hasn't been rated yet but previous editions have been among Etna's highest rated wines

2018 Azores Wine Company Arinto dos Açores Sur Lies: The Azores are a series of Portuguese-owned volcanic islands in the Atlantic. This wine, made from arinto—an indigenous Portuguese grape—on the island of Pico is dry, fresh, lively and rich. It earned 93+ from Robert Parker's Wine Advocate

2014 Fekete Pince Somloi Nagy Furmint: Béla Fekete, known as "The Grand Old Man of Somló," has been coaxing unique white wines from the volcanic mound of Somló for many decades. But in 2015, he sold control of his winery, so this is a rare chance to acquire one of his wines, made by the master. It's furmint—though, like all wines from Somló, it tastes more of the mountain than any one grape. Powerfully minerally, peppery, and brisk. It hasn't been rated by any major US publications but British critic Jamie Goode gave an earlier version 94

2015 Bott Tokaji Furmint: Judit Bodó (Bott was her maiden name) was born and raised in a Hungarian-speaking community in a part of Slovakia once known as Upper Hungary. After school, poor and in search of a job, she was hired to work for a winery—a serendipitous case of opportunity meets talent. Recognizing her ability, they sent her for an internship with a winemaker, then to Tokaji to launch a new winery. From there, it was a short leap to starting her own winery. Though she makes only a tiny amount of wine, she has become one of Hungary's most respected winemakers—Jancis Robinson's website calls her wines "mind-blowing!" This 2015 is off-dry with tree fruit flavors—long and lush.

2020 Sigalas Assyrtiko Santorini: Hailing from the gorgeous Greek island of Santorini—the remains of an ancient volcano—this is 100% assyrtiko from unique bush vines that have the grapes trained inward, toward the inside of the bush (to protect against stiff winds). Round and long, with notes of tree fruit and sea salt, this was rated 93 by Decanter

2017 Kelley Fox Maresh Vineyard Pinot Noir: While Oregon's Willamette Valley is not uniformly volcanic like Santorini or Etna (its soils were formed by dynamic geological collisions), a number of AVAs are heavily volcanic—and Maresh Vineyard in the Dundee Hills is a great example. In Kelley's hands, the result is beautiful pinot noir "a suave blend of power and finesse...with outstanding clarity and length" said Josh Raynolds of Vinous, who rated it 95

2016 Brooks Temperance Hills Pinot Noir: Temperance Hills Vineyard is located high in the windswept Eola-Amity Hills. The vines were planted there 40 years ago in volcanic basalt-jory soils. Szabo singles out Brooks and Temperance Hills for praise (as he does Kelley Fox). This is aromatic, balanced, and graceful...CT 90

2014 Soliste St. Andelain Sauvignon Blanc: This wine was made from grapes grown in a Lake County vineyard located in some of the youngest volcanic soils in California. Soliste owner (and HD supporter) Claude Koeberle was a close friend and deep admirer of the brilliant Didier Dagueneau—the "wild child of the Loire." He began making this wine as an homage after Dagueneau's tragic death, using similar techniques and the unique barrels Dagueneau invented. Rich and long. CT 90

1990 Joseph Phelps Backus Vineyard Cabernet Sauvignon: Napa is not predominantly a volcanic region, but areas certainly exist. As Szabo cites "Phelps's contribution to volcanic wines comes from Backus Vineyard on the east side of the Oakville AVA on...weathered metavolcanic rock." And perhaps it is the volcanic soils that help give this big, chocolatey, minty cab its longevity—the most recent CT rating gave the 1990 94 points

2014 Mastroberardino Taurasi Radici Riserva John Szabo writes: "The Campania Volcanic Arc is worthy of a book in itself...Mastroberardino's Radici Riserva is one of Campania's (and Italy's) top volcanic wines." Of the '14, Vinous wrote: "geared for the cellar, yet already thrilling..." (94)

NV Vinhos Barbeito Rare Wine Company Madeira Charleston Sercial This wine is a collaboration between importer Rare Wine and historic Vinhos Barbeito—one of only four producers remaining with a centuries old tradition on Madeira. Of them, Jancis Robinson wrote: "the established star of this atmospheric Atlantic island (Madeira)...is Vinhos Barbeito...." John Gilman called this bottle: "deep, full-bodied, pure and beautifully transparent...." (94)

2019 Azores Wine Company Tinto Vulcânico, Pico, Portugal (x3)

2019 Azores Wine Company Branco Vulcânico, Pico, Portugal. (50% Arinto dos Açores,

50% Verdelho) x 3 The Portuguese archipelago of the Azores is home to a winemaking tradition that dates back to its colonization in the 15th century, wherein viticulture was introduced by Franciscan friars. This group of islands is home to a singular terroir and microclimate, one that draws close comparison to the island of Santorini. Like Santorini, the Azores are volcanic islands comprised entirely of black basalt. Pico, the main wine producing island where these vineyards are located, has such poor soil that the vineyard needs to be supplemented with soil from neighboring islands to support vine growth, and even with that, the yields are a fraction of what they are in the rest of the DOC. Additionally, the vineyards are grown in tiny plots (2-6 bush trained vines per square) protected on all sides by small walls called "currais" to ward off the strong winds that blow in from the nearby beaches. Antonio Maçanita, whose heritage is directly tied to the Azores, has been a force of rejuvenation and rediscovery in these islands. Thanks to his efforts, this UNESCO heritage site is being re-established as a prestige wine-growing region in Europe. With the Vulcanico line of wines, Antonio seeks to emphasize the soil and terroir of the Azores over the varietals themselves. The Branco, Tinto and Rosé are all blends of indigenous varieties, made with minimal intervention to fully evoke the salt, wind and volcanic character of this wind-swept landscape.
