1 - bottle Robert Mondavi Reserve Cabernet Sauvignon 2010

estimated value: \$125

96 points from Jeb Dunnuck, "During my visit, I was also able to taste the 2010 Cabernet Sauvignon Reserve, which comes from a cooler year that saw a substantial heat wave later in the year. Including 4% Petit Verdot and 2% Cabernet Franc, this full-bodied, concentrated, yet balanced and impressively textured beauty offers up loads of chocolatey dark fruits, classy oak, lead pencil, and cedar-like aromas and flavors. It has a touch of Old World vibe, as do many 2010s, yet it brings classic Napa Valley fruit and texture and is a beautiful, balanced Cabernet with another 20 years of longevity ahead of it."

95 points from Robert Parker, "The 2010 Cabernet Sauvignon Reserve (a blend of 94% Cabernet Sauvignon, 4% Petit Verdot and 2% Cabernet Franc) exhibits a dense purple color, more tannin, structure and spice, terrific richness and plenty of black currant, vanillin and loamy soil characteristics. Given past track records, this full-bodied, impressive Reserve should easily age for 25-35 years."

502 **1 - Magnum Turley Hayne Vineyard Petite Syrah 2008**

estimated value: \$195

Otty Hayne planted the Hayne Petite Syrah in 1953 while he was home from college visiting his grandfather. All head-trained, dry-farmed and organic, this Petite Syrah is one of the most unique wines in California. Powerful and inky in its youth, the wine becomes more feminine and refined with age and will outlive us all.

A flâneur is a leisurely wanderer, a worldly explorer, a connoisseur of life. The word, hailing from 19th-century France, captures the idea that the mind functions best at a slow pace, and that curiosity can uncover a life of significance. Flâneur Wines live by the idea that some of the best things in life are uncovered without intention, and that life—like a good wine—should be enjoyed and appreciated.

504 **3L - Quintessa 2005**

estimated value: \$600

A classic, Bordeaux-style blend made by winemaker Charles Thomas, the 2005 Quintessa is wonderfully complex. Layers of black fruit and sweet French oak peel back on the palate to reveal velvety tannins and a sweet fruit and spice finish.

1 - Magnum Nicolas-Jay Willamette Valley Pinot Noir 2015

estimated value: \$150

Welcome back to Jay Boberg for his second Heart's Delight! This 2015 received 94 points from James Suckling "Fresh wild strawberries, cloves, nutmeg, and black cherry essence. The palate is dark-fruited with round tannins, fine acidity and a fruity finish. Layered and polished."

Fruit is sourced from almost every AVA in the Willamette Valley, ensuring optimal blending potential and representation of the diversity of pinot noir in the appellation. Unique sites include vineyards located in the high-elevation Eola-Amity Hills, the foothills of the cool coastal range in the McMinnville AVA, the warm red-soiled vineyards of the Dundee Hills and our expressive Bishop Creek Vineyard in the Yamhill-Carlton AVA. This wine is sourced almost exclusively from biodynamic, organic and LIVE certified vineyards.

5L - Chateau Montelena Chardonnay 2011

estimated value: \$390

93 points Robert Parker's Wine Advocate, "The 2011 Chardonnay appears to have more richness and body than the 2010, which is counterintuitive considering the cool year, but in 2011 Bo Barrett and his team had to wait until the end of October for this fruit to fully ripen, which, needless to say, is highly unusual. The characteristic Montelena Chardonnay aromas and flavors come through, but in a slightly richer style than normal. Hints of lemon oil, crushed rocks and flowers meld together beautifully on the resonant finish. Barrett adds that the 2011 was the first wine made in the new cellar, which is set up to handle small-lot fermentations. Whatever the reasons, the 2011 is striking in every way."

507 **Magnum Longevity Cabernet Franc 2014**

estimated value: \$75

Welcome to Phil Long for his first Heart's Delight and he brings with him a lovely magnum of his 2014 Cabernet Franc. "This wine reveals a bouquet of black currants, crushed flowers, sour cherries, dried oregano and sweet pepper. The palate bursts with mouthwatering blackberries, black cherries, white pepper, thyme and licorice. This vintage provides satisfying age-worthy structure and ample tannins." - winemaker notes

508 **6 - 500ml Rhys Vineyards Horseshoe Vineyard Chardonnay 2018**

estimated value: \$450

Jeb Dunnuck calls Rhys' 2018s "Incredible wines across the board" "Always a singular, exotic wine, the 2018 Chardonnay Horseshoe Vineyard has an incredible bouquet of crushed stone, gunpowder, tart pineapple, caramelized lemons, and musky flowers. As with all these 2018s, it has a bright spine of acidity yet is concentrated and balanced, with a wonderful texture and a great finish. This is world-class, age-worthy Chardonnay. Give bottles 2-3 years and enjoy through 2032." 97 points

509 **1 - Magnum Trombetta Family Wines Gap's Crown Vineyard Sonoma Coast Pinot Noir 2014**

estimated value: \$150

Hopefully you had a chance to taste the Trombetta wines - we are happy to welcome them for their first Heart's Delight! Juicy blackberry, dark fruit, earthy aromatics. Lush, silky fruit on the palate, finishes with a structured and lingering finish with notes of cooking spices and berry cobbler. The grapes are hand-harvested then fermented with native yeasts for an extended period of cold soak and maceration, ending with a hand-punched cap. Native malolactic fermentation occurs in barrels. Pinot Noir is aged for 9-10 months in Damy, Francois Freres, Radoux and Cadus French oak barrels; 50% new. - Winery Notes

1 - Magnum Domaine Drouhin Oregon Pinot Noir Cuvée Louise 2019

estimated value: \$230

It has been too long since we have had David Millman join us! So great to have him back! Their Cuvée Louise is a very special bottling, and extremely rare in its production. Each vintage, Véronique focuses on a few favorite barrels that, once nurtured and artfully blended, will become Louise. Seamless, complex, layered, and deeply pleasing, it is a rare and decidedly wonderful wine.

"The 2019 Pinot Noir Louise is the 20th iteration of this cuvée, and it also happens to be one of the most stunning expressions I've tasted. Medium ruby-purple, it's intensely scented of blackberry jam, Earl Grey tea and licorice with tones of charcuterie, fragrant earth and blood orange. The palate is seamless and silky, with incredible power derived from the sheer concentration of fruit on offer, and it finishes with tremendous length and layering. This marriage of power and elegance will be very long lived in the cellar. 1999, the first version of this wine, was made up of just three barrels. This 2019 incorporates about 20 barrels, so it shouldn't be too difficult to find." 98+, Wine Advocate

6 - bottles Somnium Rosé 2019

estimated value: \$225

Simultaneously bright and luscious, this rosé has all the charisma of a sunny Napa Valley morning. A brilliant watermelon-candy color hints at the intense melon and wild strawberry aromas on the nose. The wonderfully soft, full palate explodes with ripe red cherries, strawberries, and raspberries, coiled seamlessly together by energizing layers of fresh cranberry and mandarin orange zest. "Blending 85% Cabernet Sauvignon, 10% Cabernet Franc and 5% Petit Verdot, this is a hearty rendering of saignée wine taken from the tank on the first day of harvest and fermented in stainless steel. It opens in a sweetness of peach and raspberry, dark in color and thickly rich in style." 90 points - Wine Enthusiast

1 - Magnum Palmaz Vineyards Cabernet Sauvignon 2016

estimated value: \$375

This is the first Heart's Delight for Palmaz and we welcome Shawn Lutwak for his first event. Palmaz combines cutting-edge technology, talent, and a passion for producing riveting Napa Valley wines. They believe in farming each vine, rather than the entire vineyard as a whole, and they achieve this through advanced Geographic Informational Systems. They also have consultants like legendary viticulturist Mike Wolf and top consulting winemaker Mia Klein to help give voice to their incredible Coombsville vineyard. Their 2016 Napa Cabernet is classically styled, profound, and penetrating, it stunningly delivers everything Cabernet lovers want. The winery itself is an architectural marvel, extending 18 stories underground, created for gravity-flow winemaking, eliminating mechanical pumps and minimizing the turbulence that damages wines' molecular structure. Emerging from the blockbuster 2016 vintage, which ranks as the highest-rated vintage since 1997 according to the Wine Spectator Vintage Report, this 2016 is powerfully elegant and effortlessly balanced.

Following nine years in academia and significant financial debt, he moved to Los Angeles and became a United States Government bond trader. In 1994, about ten years into his bond trading career, he had his wine epiphany when a friend brought a 1991 and 1992 Williams Selyem Rochioli Vineyard Pinot Noir to share at dinner. Four years later, he left his job as a bond trader and headed to Sonoma County.

Fast forward and George is now a one-man show making highly sought-after pinot noirs in Sonoma. The wines immediately caught the attention of top sommeliers at restaurants in Las Vegas and New York and his Pinot Noir has become quite a cult wine.

George in a one-man show performing every step of winemaking from sorting to bottling, marketing and delivering.
